Painting and maintenance instructions Heritage Series doors

Heritage Series paint grade garage doors are constructed using the finest materials available for exterior applications. Every effort has been made to ensure long life and satisfactory operation. The base door panels and exterior trim have been treated with a proven, high solids, latex based primer finish.

It is very important that the door panels be finish painted immediately upon delivery. Inspect the door panels and lightly sand any rough areas. Apply a high quality exterior oil, or latex paint. A minimum of two full coats shall be applied to all surfaces of each door panel. The finish should be applied with brush and roller and not by means of air, or airless spray equipment as they have been proven to provide poor paint coverage.

Do not allow the door panels to get wet prior to paint application or finish paint failure may occur. Do not spray water under pressure (i.e.: exposed aggregate driveway spraying) on or near the door without providing protective cover). Do not install unfinished doors in applications where concrete slab pouring has not been completed as the escaping moisture will be absorbed by the door panels and can cause paint adherence problems.

Regularly inspect the painted surface for deterioration of the finish. Signs of peeling, fading, or checking mean an addition coat of paint is required. Lightly sand the surface and apply one or two coats of the same product that was originally applied.

Cleaning of the door surface should be done with a damp cloth only. Do not spray water under pressure directly at the door surface as it may lead to water infiltration and panel damage.

Failure to properly paint and maintain the finish of your garage doors panels will void your factory warranty.
